Recommended Dosages

The recommended dosage of EVA is based on a formula of 15 to 20 mgs per kilogram of bodyweight, once or twice daily. For example, a medium sized dog of 40 lbs (approximately 18 kgs), would need about 360 mgs up to twice a day. Higher doses may be used for healing or performance enhancement purposes. No side effects have been noted with the use of EVA in animals at these dosages.

EVA for pets is available in 250 to 500 mg capsules. For ease of use it's also available in a bulk powder or treat form. Like most health supplements, the effects of EVA tend to be cumulative. Typically, significant benefits can be seen after eight to 12 weeks of consistent use. Pet owners should consult a veterinarian before giving EVA to an animal.
